1. Absolutely no meat or alcohol on the Festival Grounds.
2. All payments must be complete prior to occupancy of the stalls. After July 18, 2008, all payments will be accepted only by cash, certified check, credit card, or money order.
3. All vendors must carry liability insurance. Food vendors must have food-handlers' license and liability insurance.
4. All stall vendors must request any additional tables and chairs as stipulated in the application. Payment for these items must be made together with the stall rental. We cannot guarantee additional tables and chairs for those who do not follow the above conditions. Tables and chairs will be allotted on Saturday morning of July 26th, at the HTCS stall. Vendors must pick up their tables and chairs and they are responsible for the rented items.
5. HTCS and Somerset county parks commission are not responsible for loss, theft or damage to any vendor's property. Vendors must take full responsibility and carry enough liability insurance to protect their property.

Please read the application thoroughly and follow the deadline restrictions for payment of the stalls, souvenir advertisements and cultural programs' registration. Applications can be downloaded by logging into our website: [www.venkateswara.org](http://www.venkateswara.org)

6. Bridgewater police and/or security guards from Gateway security will control all traffic at the Festival Grounds and in the parking lots.
7. All vendors must restrict their business operations to their assigned stalls or tables. No soliciting allowed beyond their assigned location.
8. Only one vehicle parking decal will be given to each vendor, for parking in the vendor designated parking lot. If vendor has additional vehicles he should park in the festival visitors parking lots. There is ample parking at the festival location.
9. Full refund for cancellation of stalls will be given with a written notification postmarked by June 20th 2008. There is no rain date for the Festival. It will be held as scheduled.
10. The Management reserves the right to cancel the festival. If canceled by the management, all the proceeds collected will be refunded
